  - b. Introduce new parents/ community members, faculty and staff who are attending.

- II. Review/Approve Meeting Minutes from May 2017 **Minutes can be viewed prior to meeting. However, today's minutes read by Kristen. See attached minutes. Motion to approve Rachelle Spencer, seconded by Lori Price.**
- III. Old Business
  - a. Open House **Open House was held on August 29<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>. It was noted that turn-out was not as good as past two years. May have been too early in the year. Also, should advertise sooner and in a variety of formats. Date should have been in place prior to beginning of year. Lack of attendance could have been because Dojo was being implemented and not all families were signed up at the time. Bethany Groves stated that as of today, 82% of families are connected to class Dojo. Partnership with Community school should allow for more involvement.**

b. iReady testing **Catching up on schedule due to hurricane days. As of this week, several students were “re-set” because of the number of days since the beginning of testing. It was suggested that the younger students need more time blocked to assist with log in. More hands would be helpful as well. QR codes can be used during lessons in class, but not during testing. Thursday, September 28<sup>th</sup> teachers will have a 2 hour training for iReady.**

#### IV. New Business

- a. **Vote on Officers (treasurer, secretary, co-chairs) Need nominees for treasurer and secretary. Treasurer will get the line budget from Tammy and will be able to collect requests. Secretary keeps minutes and attendance. Teachers need to reach out to parents to build SAC attendance and involvement. Bethany Groves nominated Teddie Grace as Secretary. Rachelle seconded. Kelsea Booth nominated Rachelle Spencer as treasurer. Lori Price seconded. Vote 12-0 to approve Teddie Grace as secretary. Vote 12-0 to approve Rachelle Spencer as treasurer.**
- b. **Set dates and times for SAC meetings As of now, the date is set as the first Thursday at 3:30. It was suggested to have at a later time. However, for now, we can leave it at 3:30, until teachers can reach out to find out if families could be more involved if time was changed. It was decided to have future meetings the second Thursday of each month at 3:30. All teachers should personally call interested parents to find out if the 3:30 time would**

work. Possibly Offer incentives for parents to receive something from the school store.

- c. **Treasurer report** Report is on hold as Mrs. Witt has had a difficult week. Rachelle will bring to next meeting.
- d. **Review Bylaws** Discussed voting member qualifications and requirements. Bethany Groves suggested posting them online to allow everyone to review them. Discuss at next meeting
- e. **Title I Parent Contract** We have to show that parents have had the opportunity to have impact. We will move requirement date to October
- f. **School Improvement Plan** Learning gains to 70% in ELA. Math is to get to 60% proficiency. Other improvement planned is to reduce incidence that require out of school suspension. Doing so by use of Class Dojo, Think Tank and a new behavior interventionist. Hopeful for the school of the arts. Journalism class interviewed a business man and author. Mrs. Lietz class is making beads and pottery to (hopefully) be sold at the Fall festival. 2-D drawing class being taught by Mrs. LaHatte. Dance is going well. An outside teacher and students from Pedro and St. Augustine High School are involved. Coach is doing a running club, he is hoping to get them in a 5K. Mrs. Nelson is starting students on drums and Orf. Symphony was asked to contribute in some way to allow exposure or opportunity for an ensemble for students to attend. Also, we are looking to partner with Murray to do workshops at both schools to support and encourage participation and mentorship. Funding to sustain the program is in the forefront. One added benefit is that the

students see different adults than they do during the school day, which helps to set the tone for the day.
