Florida Standards Assessments

We continue to receive updates from the Florida Department of Education about our springtime standardized assessments, and want to keep our parents in the loop. One important development is that 5th grade students will take the FSA Writing assessment with paper and pencil, rather than on the computer. The writing test itself will shift from a prompt to a specific task that requires students to read and analyze two-to-three pieces of text. The students will need to cite evidence from the texts to back up the claims they make. Our teachers are well-equipped to prepare our students for this increased rigor in reading, writing and test-taking stamina. Sample questions and test item specifications are available on the public website: http://www.fsassessments.org. Below are the testing windows for grades (3-5).

- March 2nd—March13th 4th & 5th FSA Writing Paper/Pencil
- March 23rd—April 10th 3rd & 4th Reading/Math Paper/Pencil
- April 13th—May 8th 5th Reading/Math Computer-based
