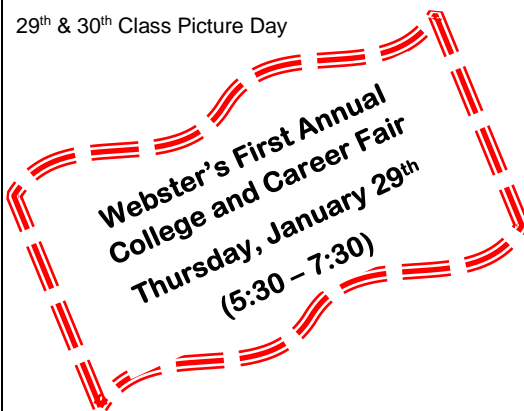

The St. Johns County School District is proud to announce that it has launched an app to provide easy access to information and resources for parents and students. The app, MySJCS, is free and currently available in both the Apple iTunes Store and Google Play Store.

MySJCS offers the ability to easily access information that is frequently visited on the school district's website including school menus, Home Access Center, volunteers, bus routes, school fees, CHARACTER COUNTS!, and the St. Johns County Education Foundation. In addition, sections for parents contain links to the Parent Resource Guide, Contests and Events, Zoning Information, the School Calendar and the Student Code of Conduct. The student section contains access to Edmodo, Study Island and Discovery Education. Content contained within the app will be expanded to accommodate additional resources as well as changes and updates as feedback is received.

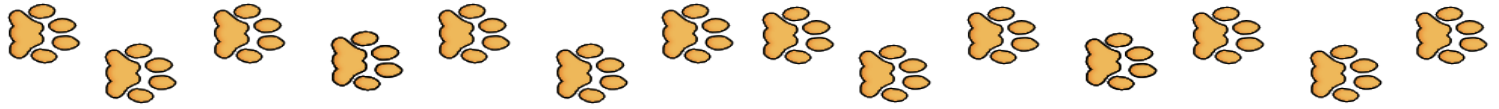
6K-\$20 before January 1, \$25 January 1-February 6, \$30 on race day

Free Office 365 ProPlus!



St. Johns County School District is proud to announce that we are one of the many school districts taking advantage of Microsoft's Advantage program. The Advantage program allows our district to provide Office 365 ProPlus FREE to active teachers and students. This program gives our students and teachers access to the latest full version of Microsoft Office at home at no additional cost.

The Office 365 ProPlus subscription license includes:

- Office 365 ProPlus for PC (2013 – Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Access, Publisher, Outlook, Lync, InfoPath)
- Office 365 ProPlus for Mac (2011 – Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook)
- Office Mobile for iPhone/Android (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote, Lync)
- Office Mobile for iPad (Word, Excel, PowerPoint)

Students and teachers must log in to Office 365 using their STJOHNS USER-ID and Password. Students who are not already using a STJOHNS account may contact their homeroom teacher to obtain their account information. Teachers should use their existing network login credentials to gain access to the program. Once the student has obtained the username and password, they can access their Office 365 ProPlus account at <http://login.microsoftonline.com>. Microsoft Student Advantage gives you Office 365 ProPlus (a full version of Office) — which includes the apps below. And, allows you to use Office apps on 5 mobile devices.
