
Volunteer of the Year!

Kindergarten, VPK and New Student Registration Information 2015 - 2016

St. Johns County will be holding registration for entering Kindergarteners and students new to St. Johns County and/or public schools at all elementary schools on the following dates:

Friday, May 8, 2015 1:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

To be eligible for kindergarten, children must be 5 years old on or before September 1st and must reside in The Webster School zone. To register for first grade, children must be 6 years old on or before September 1st and have documentation of completion of kindergarten.

Don't wait to register there are currently 20 slots available for VPK registration.

Required Documents to Register:

- 1. Proof of age: birth certificate (child must be 5 on or before Sept. 1, 2015 for K)
- 2. Proof of immunization on a Florida immunization for HRS FORM 680
- 3. School physical (must be within 12 months prior to the 1st day of school for K)
- 4. Report Card from previous school grades 1-5
- 5. 3 proofs of residency
 - 1. Mortgage statement or lease agreement
 - 2. Driver's License (with current address)
 - 3. Utility bill, car registration, property tax record or Homestead exemption
