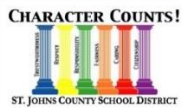
Kindergarten, VPK and New Student Registration Information 2016 - 2017

- **Monday, May 9th (1:00 p.m. – 5:00 pm)**

To be eligible for kindergarten, children must be 5 years old on or before September 1st and must reside in The Webster School zone. To register for first grade, children must be 6 years old on or before September 1st and have documentation of completion of kindergarten.

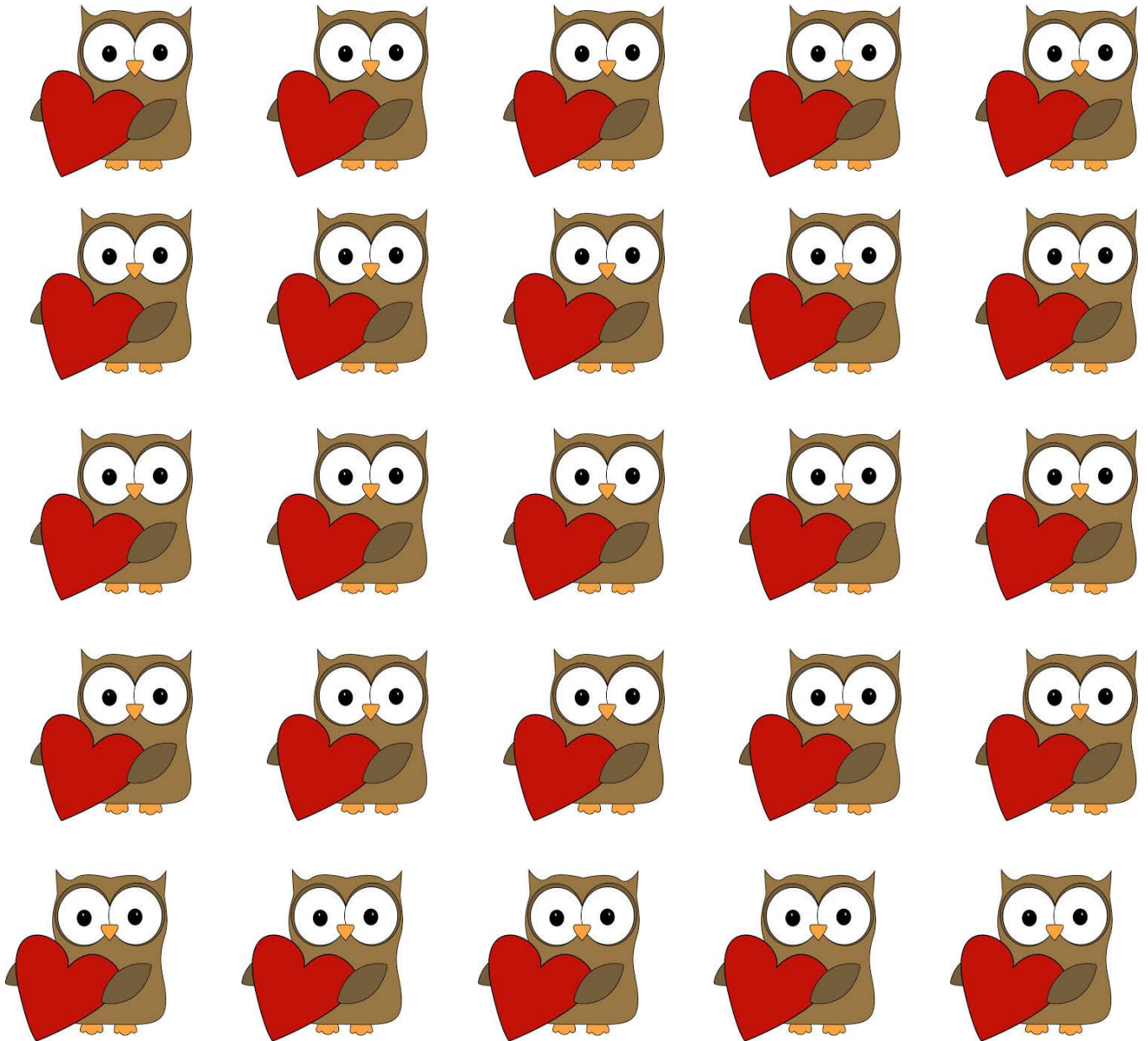

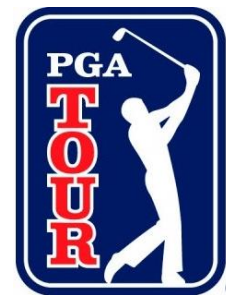
