1. Proof of age: birth certificate (child must be 5 on or before Sept. 1, 2016 for Kindergarten)
2. Proof of immunization on a Florida immunization for HRS FORM 680
3. School physical (must be within 12 months prior to the 1st day of school for Kindergarten)
4. Report Card from previous school grades 1-5
5. Three proofs of residency
  1. Mortgage statement or lease agreement
  2. Driver's License (with current address)
  3. Utility bill, car registration, property tax record or Homestead exemption

### Kindergarten, VPK and New Student Registration Information 2016 - 2017

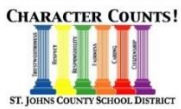
St. Johns County will be holding registration for entering Kindergarteners and students new to St. Johns County and/or public schools at all elementary schools on the following dates:

**Friday, April 8<sup>th</sup> (9:00 a.m. – 1:00 pm)**

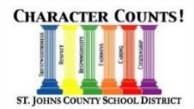
**Monday, May 9<sup>th</sup> (1:00 p.m. – 5:00 pm)**

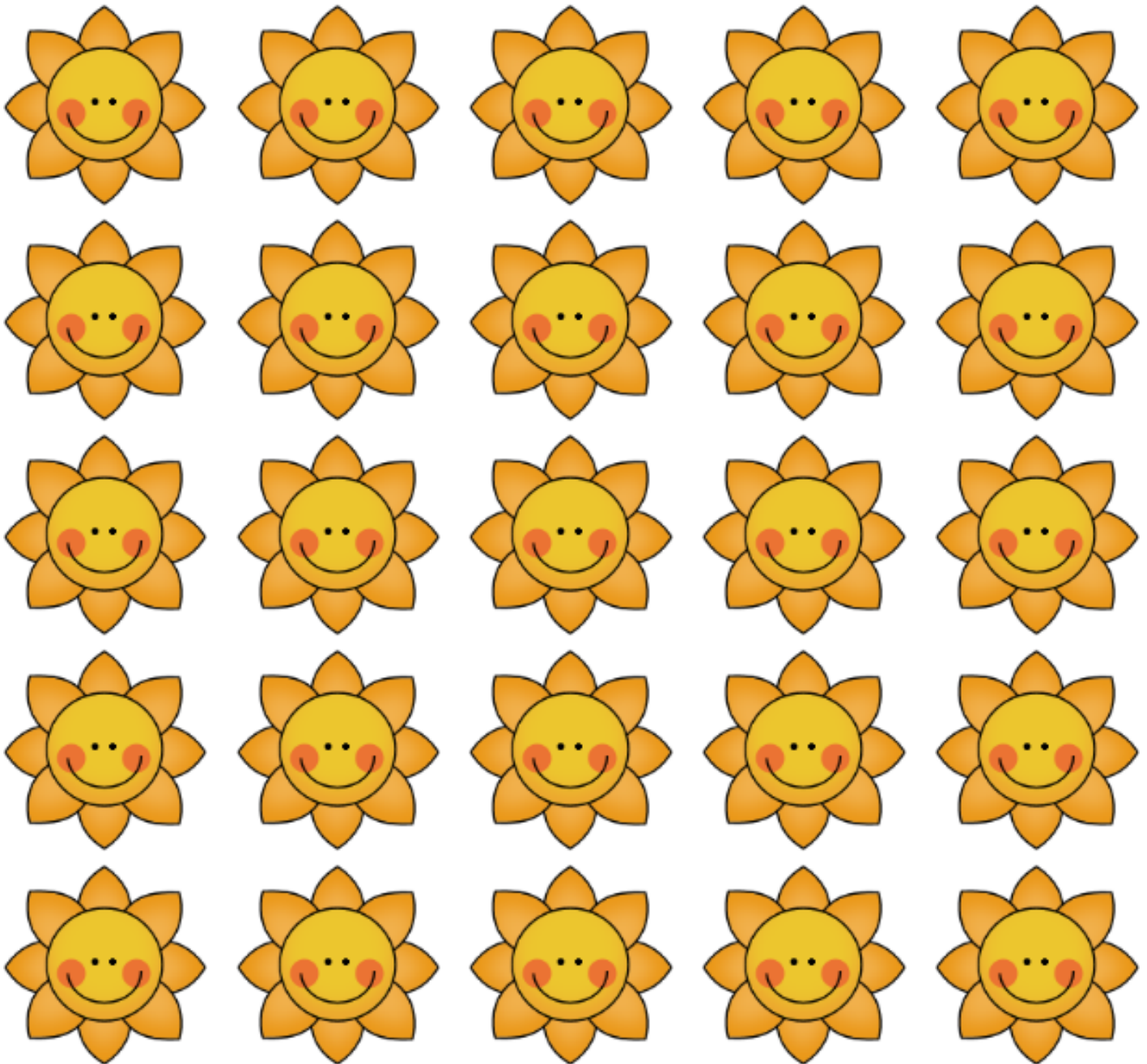
