St. Augustine's July 4th celebration by the Castillo de San Marcos

includes a live music concert and a spectacular fireworks display over the historic bayfront. Starting at 6:00 p.m., the popular local band The All Star Orchestra performs a two-hour show of big band and swing music along with patriotic favorites.

The concert is free and open to the public and everyone is encouraged to bring lounge chairs for seating. **The fireworks begin at 9:30 p.m.** St. Augustine has been putting on a spectacular fireworks show on July 4th for the last two decades. Lighting up the sky over the waters of Matanzas Bay, with the Castillo de San Marcos and the Bridge of Lions in the foreground, the "Fireworks Over the Matanzas" display is truly unforgettable. The bayfront road and South Castillo Drive will be closed to accommodate this event. The Bridge of Lions will be closed to boat and vehicle traffic. **These closures begin at 8:30 p.m. and end at 10:30 p.m., so visitors must**

make sure they are appropriately situated before then!

Required Documents to Register:

1. Proof of age: birth certificate
(child must be 5 on or before Sept. 1, 2016 for K)
2. Proof of immunization on a Florida immunization for HRS FORM 680
3. School physical
(must be within 12 months prior to the 1st day of school for K)
4. Report Card from previous school grades 1-5
5. 3 proofs of residency
 1. Mortgage statement or lease agreement
 2. Driver's License (with current address)
 3. Utility bill, car registration, property tax record or Homestead exemption
