Starting at 6:00 p.m., the popular local band The All Star Orchestra performs a two-hour show of big band and swing music along with patriotic favorites.


The concert is free and open to the public and everyone is encouraged to bring lounge chairs for seating. **The fireworks begin at 9:30 p.m.** St. Augustine has been putting on a spectacular fireworks show on July 4th for the last two decades. Lighting up the sky over the waters of Matanzas Bay, with the Castillo de San Marcos and the Bridge of Lions in the foreground, the "Fireworks Over the Matanzas" display is truly unforgettable. - 4. Report Card from previous school grades 1-5
- 5. 3 proofs of residency
 - 1. Mortgage statement or lease agreement
