We will continue to build good reading habits through IDR (Individualized Daily Reading). Following good reading habits will be a focus on text structure in Non-Fiction text.

Math: Currently, we are working on place value, addition & subtraction of multi-digit numbers and moving into multiplication and solving real-world problem.
