Reading: Our focus in pre-k is learning the alphabet in both upper and lower case letters, and their letter sounds. We work on one letter each week. We also work on recognizing their names in the environment.

Writing: Our writing in pre-k starts with tracing their names. Students are encouraged to write during our free choice centers, use writing materials properly, and work on fine motor skills to increase their hand strength.

Math: Math focus includes colors, shapes, numbers, counting, patterns, sorting and numerals. Goals are highlighted with our TS Gold assessments, and are developmentally and academically relevant to each student.

Science: Pre-K Free Choice Centers include a Discovery Center. In this center, students interact with environmental materials using magnifying glasses, magnets, weights and measures.

Social Studies: We began the year with a focus on pedestrian safety and following classroom and school rules. Pre-K is a very social environment, where students learn to share, take turns and get along with their peers. Students learn to follow the classroom management system particular to their class.
